

***The best hot and sour soup I tried during my survey was served at Yeuh Tung Restaurant at 126 Elizabeth Street, just off Dundas, near Bay, tucked behind what used to be City Hall. Almost a year ago, Yueh Tung moved across Elizabeth Street to a space that is much more pleasant, bright and modern than its previous digs. This hot and sour soup got everything right: the broth was of perfect consistency — appealingly thick but not gloppy — and was chock full of baby shrimp, bamboo shoots, tofu, mushrooms, slivers of barbecued pork and, two terrific additions, crunchy green pepper and sweet emerald-green peas. The heat was perfect, and was balanced by an ideal level of sourness; needless to say, Yeuh Tung's soup passed the sniffle test.***
